


Passing the Days: 20-Goblet



Cutting Directions:

Light Fabric:

A (cut 2) 3" x 3"

Medium Fabric:

B (cut 2) 3" x 3"

C (cut 1) 2½" x 2½"

D (cut 2) 1½" x 1½"


Dark Fabric:

E (cut 2) 2½" x 2½"

F (cut 2) 2½" x 2½"


Directions: See General Instruction for piecing various aspects of the block. (Press as indicated by arrows.)

1. Use the A and B squares to make four Half-square Triangles. Press three towards B and one towards A.




2. Trim to 2½" x 2½".


3. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the D squares. Place right sides together in one corner of the E squares.




4. Sew a needle width along the outside of the line. Do not sew right on top of the line.




5. Trim off excess if desired.




6. Press towards D.



7. Lay out all of the units as shown, placing the A/B HST that was pressed towards A in the upper right corner as shown. Match seams and sew together into rows.



9. Join these rows to complete the block. Block measures 6½” x 6½” unfinished.



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
