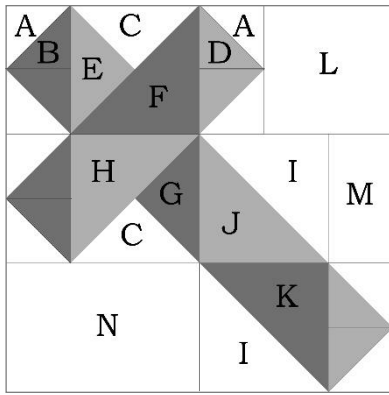



# Passing the Days: 27-Easter Cross




## Cutting Directions:

 =Cut in half diagonally: yields 2 triangles.

 =Cut twice diagonally: yields 4 triangles.

### Light Fabric:

A (cut 4)  $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{4}$ "

C (cut 1)  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " 

I (cut 2) 3" x 3"


L (cut 1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ "


M (cut 1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ "

N (cut 1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ "

### Medium Fabric:

D (cut 4)  $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{4}$ "


E (cut 1)  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " 


H (cut 1)  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " 

J (cut 1) 3" x 3"

### Dark Fabric:

B (cut 4)  $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{4}$ "

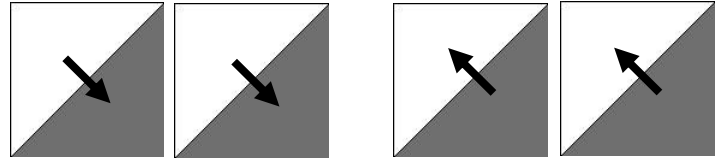
F (cut 1)  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " 

G (cut 1)  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " 

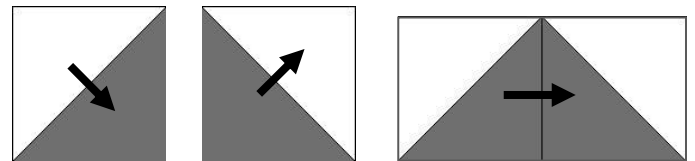
K (cut 1) 3" x 3"

## Directions:

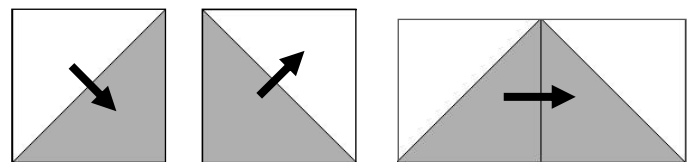
1. Use A and B squares to make four Half-square Triangles. Press two of them to the dark side and two to the light side. (See General Instructions) Trim to  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $1\frac{1}{2}$ ".



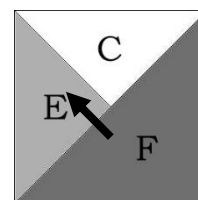
2. Join the HST's to make two Flying Geese units as shown, matching the seams that are pressed in opposite directions to make each. These measure  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ ".



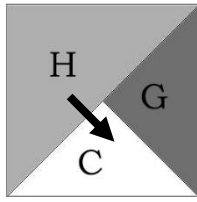
3. Repeat steps 1 and 2 using the A and D squares.



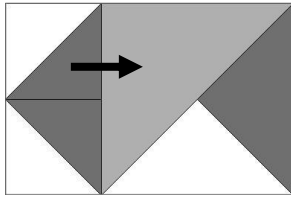
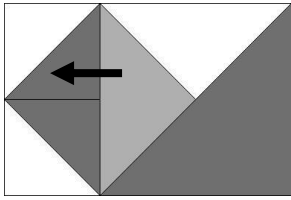
4. Use the C, E and F triangles to make one Split Corner-square Triangle. You only use one of each triangle here so there are extra triangles left over. (See General Instruction sheet for "Split Corner-square Triangles that are Identical".) Press as indicated. Unit measures  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ ". Trim if needed.



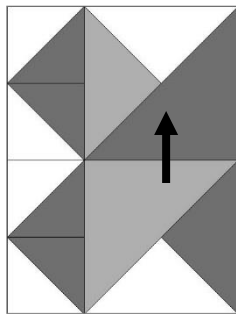
**5.** Use the C, G and H triangles to make another Split Corner-square Triangle. Press as indicated. Unit measures  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ ". Trim if needed.



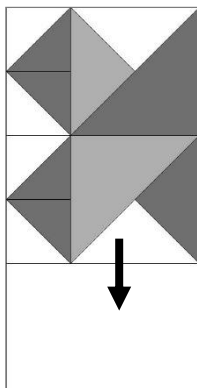
**6.** Join the A/B Flying Geese to the left side of each Split Corner-square Triangle.



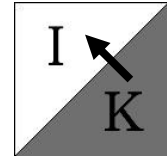
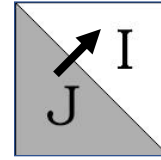
**7.** Join these two units together.



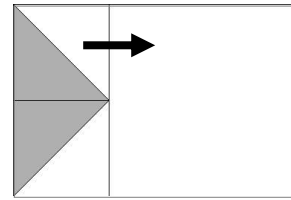
**8.** Add the N rectangle to the bottom. Unit now measures  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ ".



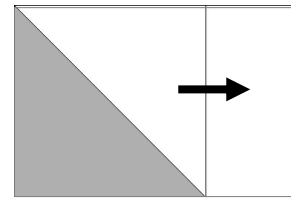
**9.** Use the I squares with the J and K squares to make two Half-square Triangles. You only need one of each. Trim to  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ ".



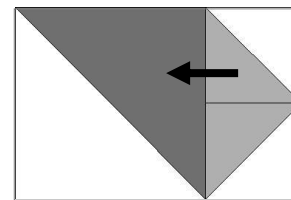
**10.** Join the L square to the right side of one of the A/D Flying Geese.



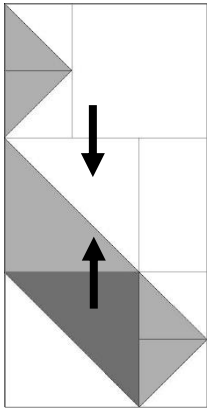
**11.** Join the M rectangle to the right side of the I/J HST.



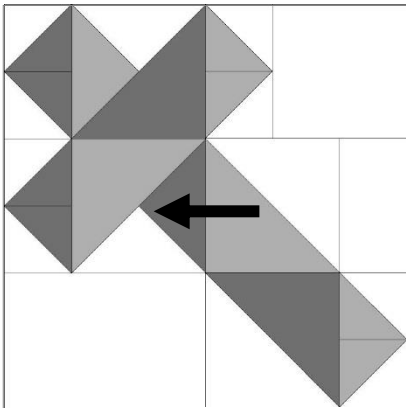
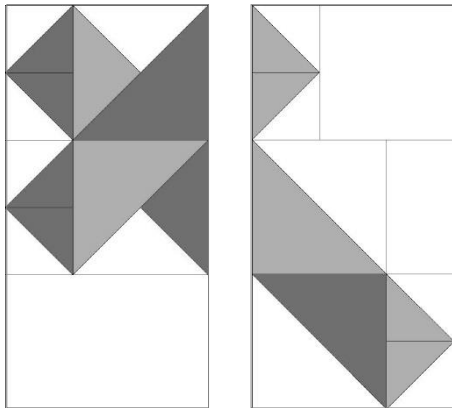
**12.** Join the other A/D Flying Geese to the right side of the I/K HST.



**13.** Now join these three units together.



**14.** Lay out both units as shown. Join together matching seams. Block measures 6½" x 6½" unfinished.



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
