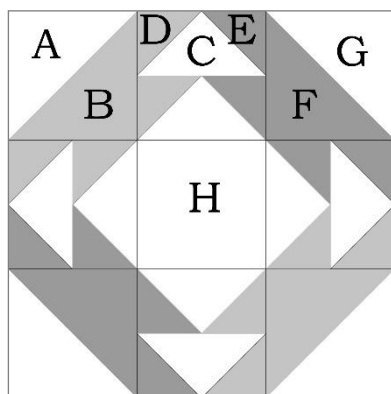


Passing the Days: 32-Cups and Saucers



Cutting Directions:

Light Fabric:

A (cut 1) 3" x 3"

C (cut 2) 3½" x 3½"

G (cut 1) 3" X 3"

H (cut 1) 2½" x 2½"

Medium Fabric#:

B (cut 1) 3" x 3"

D (cut 4) 2½" x 2½"

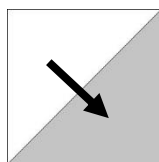
Dark Fabric:

E (cut 4) 2½" x 2½"

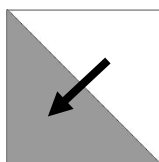
F (cut 1) 3" x 3"

Directions: Arrows indicate pressing direction.

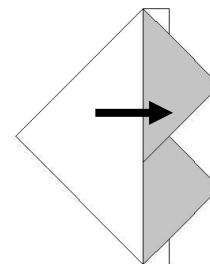
1. Use the A and B squares to make two half-square Triangles. Trim to 2½" x 2½". See General Instruction Sheet for step-by-step if needed.



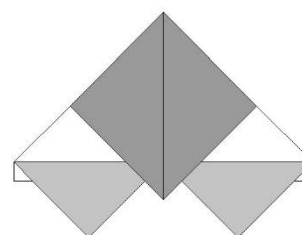
2. Repeat using the F and G squares to make two more HST's.



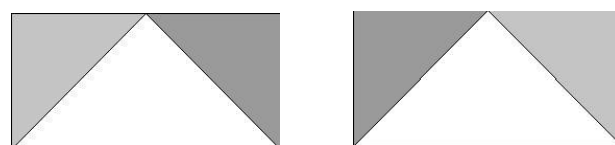
3. Follow Directions in General Instructions for Flying Geese. These will be made using three colors. Start with the D and C squares to complete the first 2 steps.



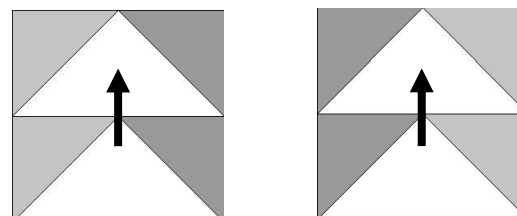
4. Now add the E squares for the next step.



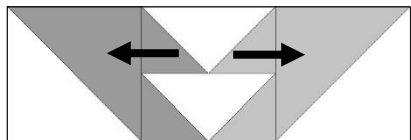
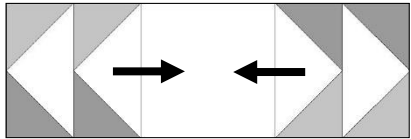
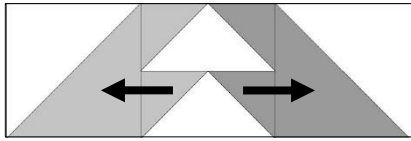
5. You will have a total of eight Flying Geese. Four will be oriented one way and four the other. Trim to 1½" x 2½".



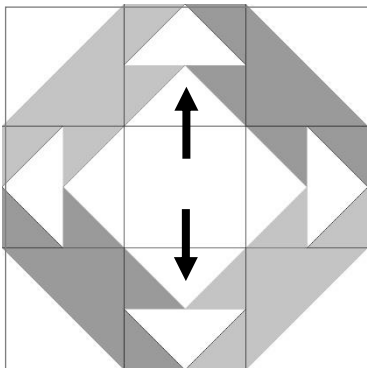
6. Join these together into four pairs as shown, making two of each. These units now measure 2½" x 2½".



7. Arrange the units to make the block and join into three rows.



8. Join these rows to complete the block. Block measures 6½" x 6½" unfinished.



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
