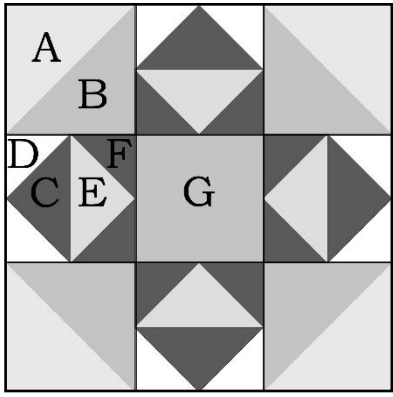


Passing the Days: 37-Pointed Star



Cutting Directions:

Light Fabric #1:

D (cut 4) 2½” x 2½”

Light Fabric #2:

E (cut 1) 3½” x 3½”

Medium Fabric #1:

A (cut 2) 3” x 3”

Medium Fabric #2:

B (cut 2) 3” x 3”

G (cut 1) 2½” x 2½”

Dark Fabric:

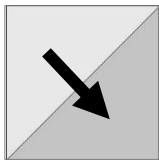
C (cut 1) 3½” x 3½”

F (cut 4) 2½” x 2½”

Directions: Use ¼” seam allowance. Press as indicated by arrows.

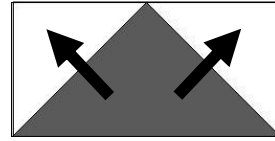
See General Instruction Sheet for Step-by-Step guide to making Half-square Triangles (HST) and Flying Geese units.

1. Use the A and B squares to make eight Half-square Triangles. Press towards B.

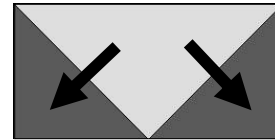


2. Trim to 2½” x 2½”.

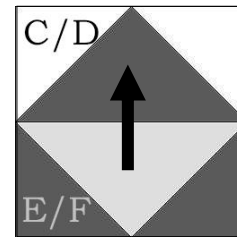
3. Use the C and D squares to make four Flying Geese units. Trim to 1½” x 2½”.



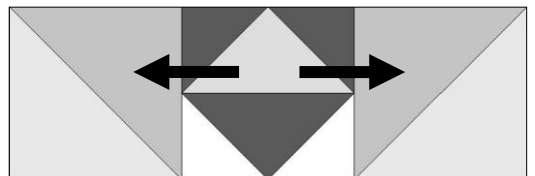
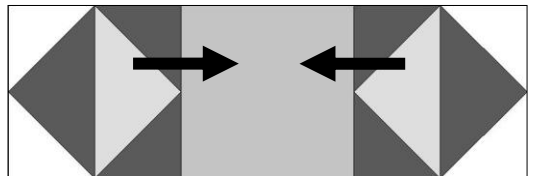
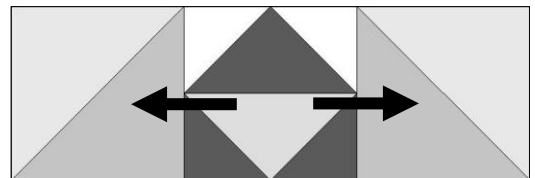
4. Use the E and F squares to make four more Flying Geese units. Trim to 1½” x 2½”.



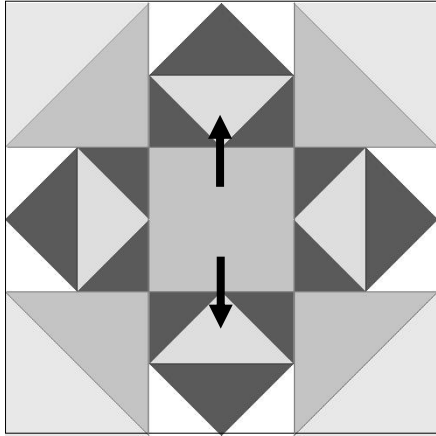
5. Join the C/D Flying Geese to the E/F Flying Geese as shown. These units measure 2½” x 2½”.



6. Lay out units, with the G square, as shown. Sew together into rows.



7. Join these rows to complete the block.
Block measures 6½" x 6½" unfinished.



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
