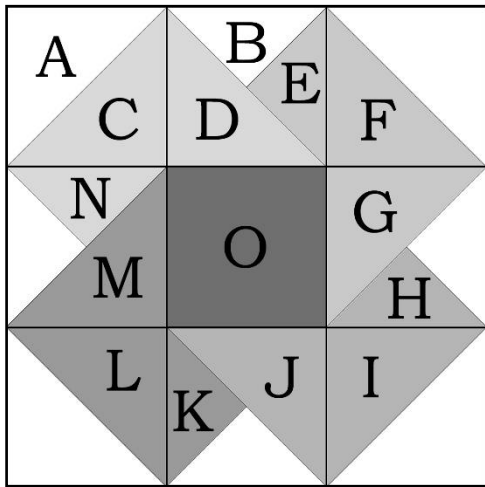


Passing the Days: 43-Colorwheel



Cutting Directions:

☐ = Cut in half diagonally: yields 2 triangles.

☒ = Cut twice diagonally: yields 4 triangles.

*You will have extra triangles left over that are not used to make this block.

Light Fabric:

A (cut 4) 3" x 3"

B (cut 1) 3¼" x 3¼" ☒

Medium Fabric #1:

C (cut 1) 3" x 3"

D (cut 1) 2⅞" x 2⅞" ☐

N (cut 1) 3¼" x 3¼" ☒

Medium Fabric #2:

E (cut 1) 3¼" x 3¼" ☒

F (cut 1) 3" x 3"

G (cut 1) 2⅞" x 2⅞" ☐

Medium Fabric #3:

H (cut 1) 3¼" x 3¼" ☒

I (cut 1) 3" x 3"

J (cut 1) 2⅞" x 2⅞" ☐

Medium Fabric #3:

K (cut 1) 3¼" x 3¼" ☒

L (cut 1) 3" x 3"

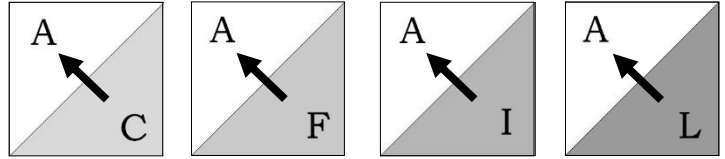
M (cut 1) 2⅞" x 2⅞" ☐

Dark Fabric:

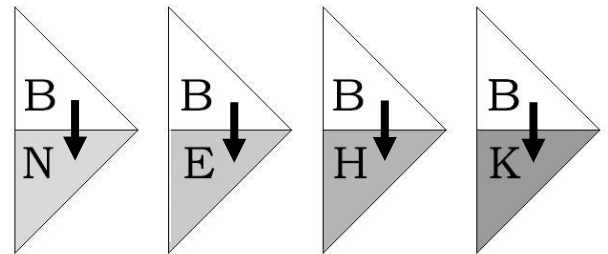
O (cut 1) 2 ½" x 2 ½"

Directions: (Press as indicated by arrows.)

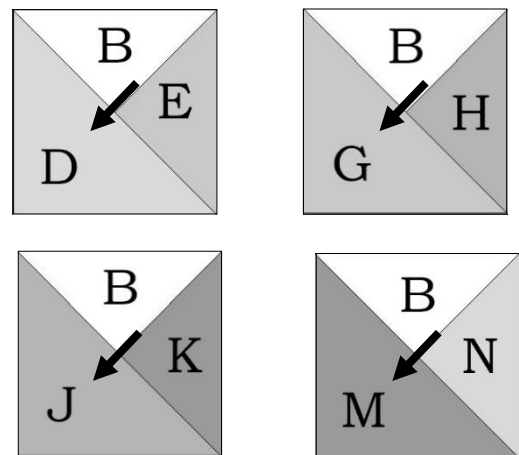
1. Make Half-square Triangles (one each) in the following combinations: A/C, A/F, A/I, and A/L. Press. Trim to 2½" x 2½".



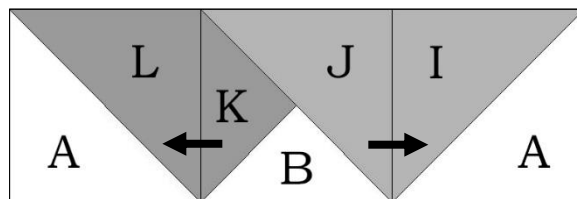
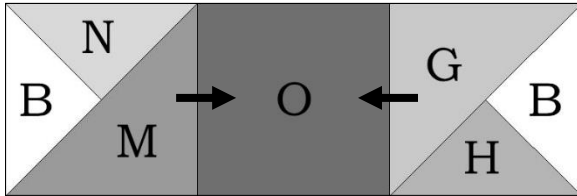
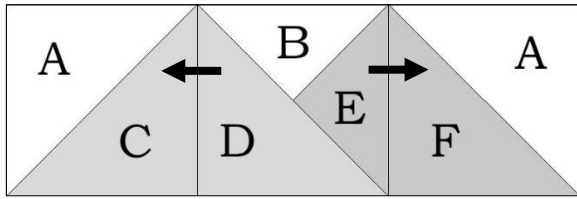
2. Join the B triangles with one E, one H, one K, and one N triangle as shown. Press. See General Directions for specific instructions for making Split Quarter-square Triangles.



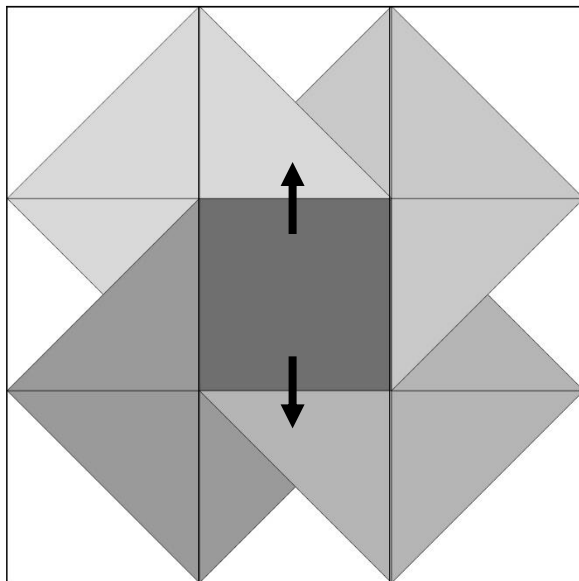
3. Add the large triangles in the combinations shown to complete four Split Quarter Square Triangles. Trim to 2½" x 2½".



8. Lay out all of the units as shown. Watch direction that they are facing. Match seams and sew together into rows.



9. Join these rows to complete the block. Block measures 6½" x 6½" unfinished.
