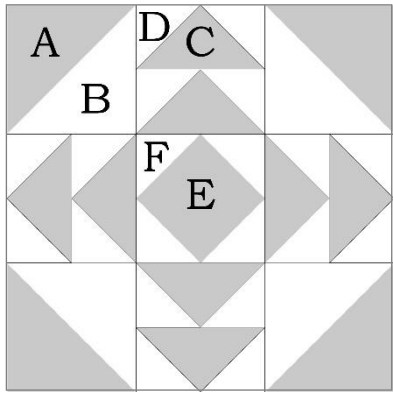


# Passing the Days: 47-Illinois



## Cutting Directions:

### Light Fabric:

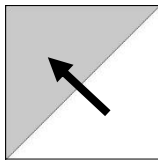
- B (cut 2) 3" x 3"
- D (cut 8) 2½" x 2½"
- F (cut 4) 1½" x 1½"

### Medium Fabric#:

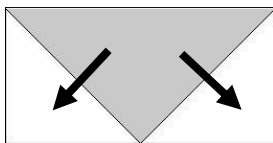
- A (cut 2) 3" x 3"
- C (cut 2) 3½" x 3½"
- E (cut 1) 2½" x 2½"

**Directions:** Arrows indicate pressing direction.

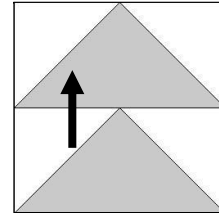
1. Use the A and B squares to make four half-square Triangles. Trim to 2½" x 2½". See General Instruction Sheet for step-by-step if needed.



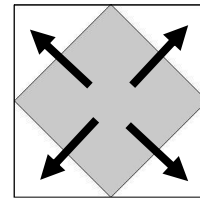
2. Follow Directions in General Instructions for Flying Geese. Make 8 Flying Geese using the C and D squares. Trim to 1½" x 2½"



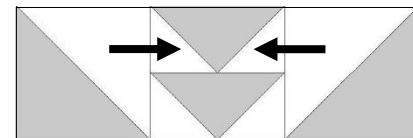
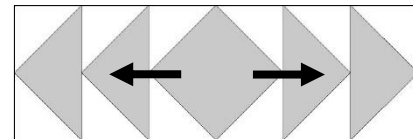
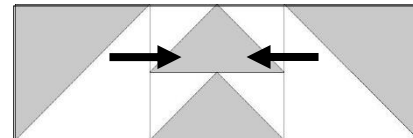
3. Join the Flying Geese units together to make four pairs as shown. These units now measure 2½" x 2½".



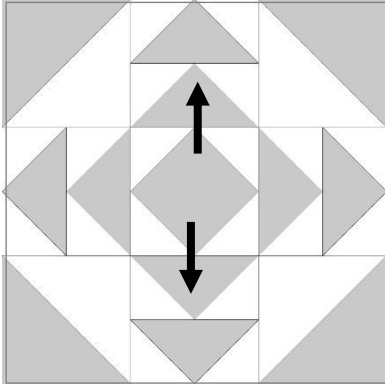
4. Use the E and F squares to make the center square. Trim to 2½" x 2½". See General Instruction Sheet for Quick Corner Squares step-by-step if needed.



5. Arrange the units to make the block and join into three rows.



**6.** Join these rows to complete the block.  
Block measures 6½" x 6½" unfinished.



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
