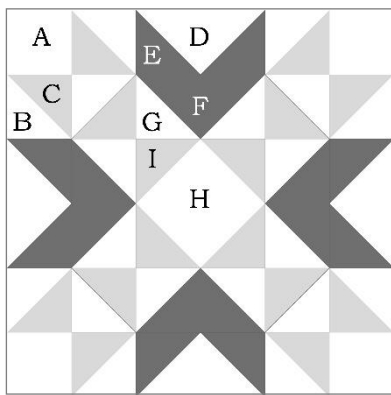


Passing the Days: 70-Remember



Cutting Directions:

Light Fabric:

- A (cut 4) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ "
- B (cut 6) 2" x 2"
- D (cut 1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ "
- G (cut 4) $2\frac{1}{8}$ " x $2\frac{1}{8}$ "
- H (cut 1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ "

Medium Fabric:

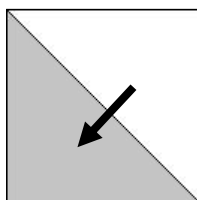
- C (cut 6) 2" x 2"
- I (cut 4) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ "

Dark Fabric:

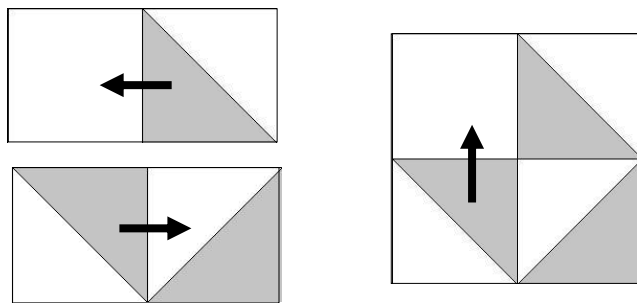
- E (cut 4) $2\frac{1}{8}$ " x $2\frac{1}{8}$ "
- F (cut 1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ "

Directions: Arrows indicate pressing direction.

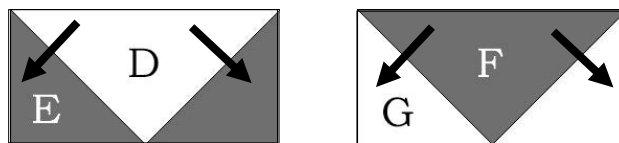
1. Use the B and C squares to make 12 Half-square Triangles. Press as indicated. Trim to $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ ".



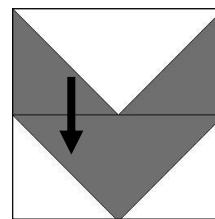
2. Join these with the A squares as shown to make four corner units. These measure $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ ".



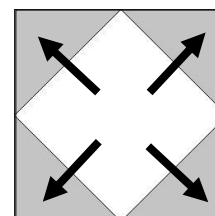
3. Follow Directions in General Instructions for Flying Geese using the D and E squares. Trim to $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ ". Repeat using the F and G squares.



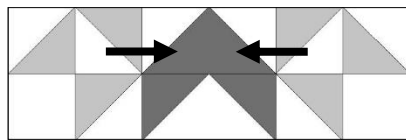
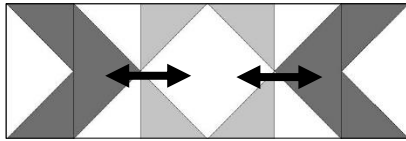
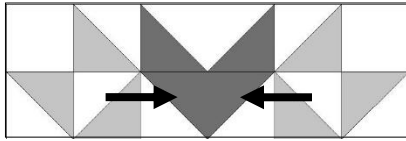
4. Join the Flying Geese units together as shown. These units now measure $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ ".



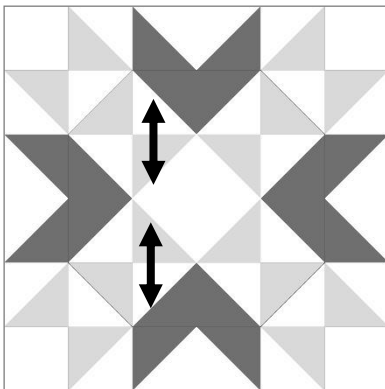
5. Follow Directions in General Instructions for Quick Corner Triangles using the F, and G squares. This units measures $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ ".



6. Arrange the units in order and join into three rows. Press as indicated.
(\longleftrightarrow means to press seams open.)



7. Join these rows to complete the block.
Block measures $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.



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
