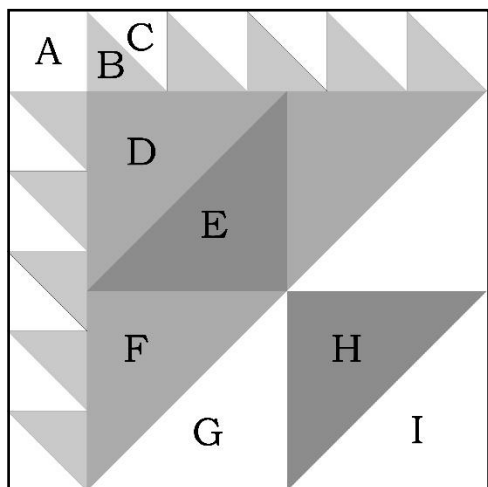


Passing the Days: 80-Birthday Cake



Cutting Directions:

Light Fabric:

- A (cut 1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ "
- C (cut 5) 2" x 2"
- G (cut 1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ "
- I (cut 1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ "

From Medium Fabrics:

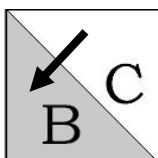
- B (cut 5) 2" x 2"
- D (cut 1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ "
- F (cut 1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ "

From Dark Fabrics:

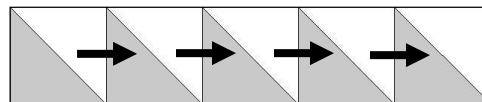
- E (cut 1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ "
- H (cut 1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ "

Directions: (Press as indicated by arrows.)

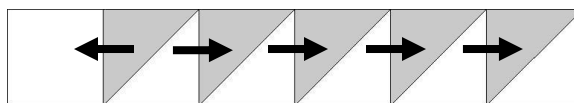
1. Use the B and C squares to make ten Half-square Triangles (HST). Trim to $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ ".



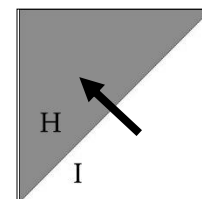
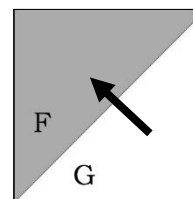
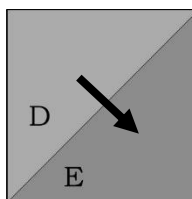
2. Lay out five of the HST's as shown to make one unit. This unit measures $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ ".



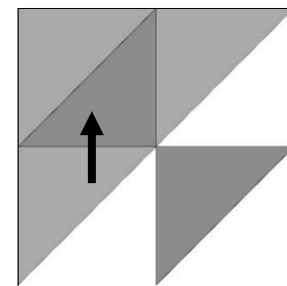
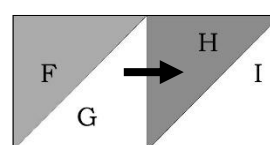
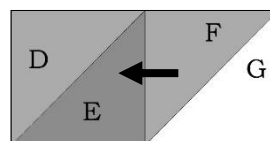
3. Lay out five of the HST's with the A square as shown to make one unit. This unit measures $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ ".



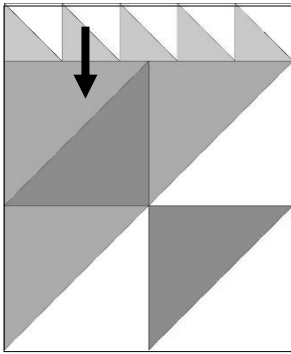
4. Use the D and E squares to make two Half-square Triangles (HST). You will only use one for the block. Trim to 3" x 3". Repeat using the F/G squares to make two and the H/I squares to make one.



5. Join the HST's from Step 4 as shown. The four-square unit measures $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ ".

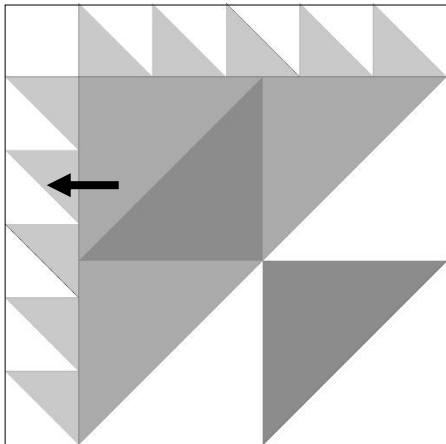


^ Add the unit from Step 2 to the top of the four-square unit just made.



3. Now add the unit from Step 3 to complete the block.

Block measures $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.



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
